Proceeds of the evening go directly to Fight Abuse in the Home (FAITH), a non-profit organization, and their yearly operating costs. FAITH Director Caroline White reports the evening typically brings in \$50K.

A small group of local volunteers started FAITH in 1993 with a recognized need. The organization has grown into an integral part of Rabun and surrounding counties. FAITH operates a 24-hour shelter and hotline service and the Power House for Kid's shelter (Toccoa, GA). At these secure centers is where clients receive legal advocacy, therapy, and job and life skills free of charge. Caroline reports the shelter served 421 clients with a steady 98% capacity and the Power House for Kids in Toccoa served over 350 youth. (Please see the Ga. Mtn. FAITH also has four instructors who offer [Darkness 2 Light](#) training in a three-country area. This program empowers participants to help anyone they encounter that they suspect could be a victim of child sexual abuse. Most victims stay silent and FAITH works to educate all to make communities safer. (This program is now required for all Public School employees in Rabun County.) Their services rely on funding from FAITH's annual ball, their thrift store (downtown Clayton), grants, and other donations.

Kathy English, FAITH Vice President, reports the ball is well on its way to being one of the best yet, "The décor will be strikingly elegant!"




