
Heaven's Landing Success!



The AirCam Visits Heaven

Being in the right place at the right time is one thing, but being an owner at Heaven's Landing is *everything*. Everything for your happiness, well-being, and for feeding your adventurous spirit. That is certainly the case if you asked those who were fortunate enough to be hanging around the airfield on Tuesday, August 6.

Why so much joy? Phil Lockwood, designer, owner, and passionate pilot of [AirCam](#), an experimental homebuilt aircraft, visited us at Heaven's Landing. Phil is an occasional guest to our area and has often networked with Mike and Holly Ciochetti at the air shows over the years. Phil made arrangements with Mike to stop for the night on his way home to Sebring, Florida from Oshkosh, Wisconsin and EAA's AirVenture. Phil's back-story is amazing, and what I don't cover you will enjoy reading at this [link](#) and those found below.

The AirCam was born in the mid 90's out of necessity and a great passion for "low and slow exploration and photography." Phil had, for years, assisted in film productions and projects involving aerial work, with his previous aircraft and the predecessor to the AirCam, the [Drifter](#). With his expertise in design and innovation, Phil eventually found himself working with National Geographic explorers, filmmakers and photographers, [Des and Jen Bartlett](#). About the time the Bartlett's were accepting their Emmy for their production, "Survivors of the Skeleton Coast," Phil was approached by award winning photographer, [Nick Nichols](#), and conservationist, [Dr. Michael Fay](#), for their [project in the Congo](#) region of Africa. "I had already been thinking about how I could build a twin [engine] that would fly low over hostile un-landable terrain and provide some additional safety," Phil recalls, "—which is always what these people want to fly over....I had done some design work and National Geographic ultimately said, 'build it.'" (You can find the [AirCam 1](#) hanging in the [EAA museum](#).)

Phil reports his current clientele is anyone who is simply passionate about the pure beauty of flight. He specifies that airline pilots, have been his best customers. Those who absolutely love to fly and by nature are seeking safe redundant systems in a fast build kit (approximately 1200 hours). The AirCam features twin engines, 2 fuel tanks, and 2 backup fuel pumps and electrical systems just to name a few key features. The fuel economy is outstanding. If you are flying at 55 mph you will burn at the rate of about 3.5 gph total for the two engines (aircam.com).

Ok, so out of the wilds of Africa, let's go back to the Heaven's Landing hangar complex on that Tuesday morning! The lucky Heaven's Landing owners who Phil took for AirCam tours included, Mike and Holly Ciochetti, Jim and Ginger Tomaszewski, and Joahn Facey. The visuals really speak for themselves; but what one AirCam owner describes in the [promotion video](#) as "the AirCam Smile" is what I could tangibly feel from my interviews with these participants who were *still beaming* several weeks later!

The Aircam continued...

Pure joy and lasting excitement over this little kit plane. “It is the *funnest* [sic], and I’m going to use that word, airplane I have ever flown in my life, -not by a little, -but a lot!” Mike exclaimed. Even after fighting a virus all week, Holly climbed out of the seat grinning from ear to ear proclaiming “This is the one! When I learn to fly, I want this one!” Ginger opted to sit in the back seat, explaining that she was a little nervous and felt the second seat choice made her more at ease; but as soon as she landed, with delight in her eyes, she proclaimed she would never hesitate to be in front. “We’ve of course seen Heaven’s Landing from the air, but to be soaring just above the tree line, was magnificent,” Ginger reported. Jim, a world traveling professional pilot, noted, “I’ve never done anything like this before. Never sky dived. Never been in an open cockpit. But this is the best thing I’ve ever done in an airplane!” And Joahn, also a pilot, stated “The AirCam ride was sensational! Definitely the way to fly through the trees like a bird. Best ride I can think of in our beautiful mountains!”



Everyone is truly grateful for Phil’s visit. The long distance flight he took back and forth to AirVenture was an opportunity he couldn’t pass up. “You are going slow and you plan ahead,” Phil notes, “but it is such a pleasure in the journey to the destination. You land in friendly small airports, meet the greatest people, and always get pointed in the right direction for the best local meals.”

Every HL passenger agrees the ride is extremely relaxing and comfortable and everyone agrees they are blessed individuals having experienced *everything* one could ask for!

Drive-ins are an American icon. It all began in Camden, New Jersey when the first feature was shown in 1933 to happy families and young couples. The industry took off and peaked in the United States in the 50's and 60's. Once you would find a theater within a [short distance to your hometown](#), but those days are gone and going fast.



Currently there are 448 drive-in theaters around the world and 368 remaining in the United States. Why would you go outdoors to see a movie? The best way to explain the experience is a block party with a projector. Kids have a blast with their friends playing ball or frolicking on the playground, parents and couples have a great view of the complex from the comfort of their car or lounge chair. You are free to eat your snacks, dinner, or maybe a birthday cake right there on the lawn. No worries if the baby cries or the cell phone rings, you are there with stereo sound, in or near the comfort of your vehicle.



Here in Rabun County just a few minutes from Heaven's Landing, we are blessed with the [Tiger Drive-In](#). This resurrected theater, had its first hay-day in the mid 50's and continued strong for several decades until it struggled and closed in the mid 80's. Daylight savings, demands of movie distributors, and the advent of home movie rentals all added to the decline in popularity of drive-ins. However, Sherryl Major, the daughter of one of the original owners of Tiger Drive-In, was driven to share the joy she grew up with—the joy of the community coming together. In 2004, Sherryl reopened the theater, and it has delighted individuals, families, and couples since.

Now drive-ins, as a whole, face a new huddle –the need to [upgrade to digital projectors](#), at a cost of \$80K and upwards. We love our local drive-in and that cost is extraordinary for this small town theater. We ask that you do your part to preserve this amazing venue. First, visit [this website, at Project Drive-In](#) and watch the video, then click the “vote” button. Honda Motor Company is giving away several projectors to drive-ins around the country. Tiger Drive-in needs your vote, and you may vote *every day* until **September 9**.



Second, take in a single or a double feature before the season ends in what maybe, sadly, your last chance. Tiger Drive in is opened weekends until late November. Check their website for [“Now Playing.”](#) we are sure you'll have a unique, fun-filled experience. We've seen giant river rafts, pillows and cushions in pick-ups and simple campfire chairs as “theater seats.” Bring what you like, share a blanket with a loved one and enjoy their great meals at the concession stand. 
